TOILET PAPER TUBE BIRDS



AGE RANGE: All ages

TIME NEEDED: Under 30 minutes

MATERIALS YOU'LL NEED:

- Toilet paper tubes
- Hot glue gun with glue
- Paints or markers
- Any kind of string/ribbon that you like
- Optional: paperclips or wire for legs

STEPS:

- 1. Flatten one end of the tube horizontally and hot glue the end together.
- 2. Flatten the other end of the tube vertically and round the corners with scissors this will be the bird's face.
- 3. Take one of the corners that you snipped off to make the beak depending on the type of bird you're making; you may need to trim or shape your "beak" a bit.
- 4. On the top of your bird make a small hole just big enough to feed your ribbon or sting through. Make a loop with the string and tie a knot on the inside of your bird. This will create a way to hang your bird on the tree.
- 5. Hot glue the two sides of your bird's "face" together but be sure to add the beak in before completely gluing this end shut.
- 6. Decorate your new bird like your favorite Alaskan bird.
- 7. Optional: Give your bird legs! Unfold paperclips and shape into legs and feet for your bird. Attach to the bottom of your bird with hot glue.
